



Terms and Conditions for Visiting the National Avian Research Center (NARC)

1- Purpose of Visit:

I. Visits are conducted to present the work performed at the National Avian Research Center (NARC), a captive breeding program, that contribute to the conservation of sustainable populations of Asian Houbara Bustard (Chlamydotis macqueenii).

2- Entry Requirements:

- I. Access is limited to pre-authorized visitors only. Walk-ins are not permitted.
- II. Visitors must provide valid identification in advance for pre-approval purposes.
- III. Access is restricted to designated areas only.
- IV. Gatekeepers might request identification to grant entry into the site.

3- Health & Safety Requirements:

- I. Visitors must follow all site-specific safety rules and procedures given by staff.
- II. Visitors are required to use PPE (Personal protective equipment) provided to them.
- III. Visitors must follow Emergency procedures and evacuation instructions.
- IV. Visitors must respect speed limits.
- V. Visitors must use reversed parking.
- VI. Drugs, alcohol, and weapons are prohibited.

4- Biosecurity measures:

- I. Visitors are required to meet Hygiene Requirements (e.g. handwashing, sanitization).
- II. Disinfection is a must upon entry and exit of sectors and sub-sectors.
- III. Visitors will be requested to change clothing and shoes during the visit.

5- Access Restrictions:

- I. Visitors cannot access any sector unescorted unless formally authorized.
- II. Visitors must always remain with their assigned staff member.
- III. Pets are strictly not allowed on-site.

6- Prohibited Conduct:

- I. Tampering with equipment or materials.
- II. Disruptive behaviour, disrespect toward staff or failure to observe local customs and cultural norms will not be tolerated.





III. Theft, vandalism, or unauthorized use of Property.

7- Liabilityand Indemnity:

- I. Visitors waive liability claims except in case of gross negligence.
- II. Visitors agree to indemnify the site for damage caused by their actions.

8- Confidentiality:

- I. Visitors must not disclose, duplicate or use any confidential information they might encounter / obtained during the visit without prior written consent.
- II. Photography, video/audio recording, or data collection is prohibited unless explicitly authorized.

9- Consent and Acknowledgement:

- I. Visitors acknowledge having read and understood all the Terms and Conditions.
- II. Visitors agree to comply as a condition of the visit.
- III. Visitors commit to informing the National Avian Research Center if they need to cancel their visit.

10- Breach of Terms:

- I. National Avian Research Center (NARC) reserve the right to deny entry or remove a visitor from the premises for any breach of the Terms and Conditions.
- II. National Avian Research Center (NARC) reserve the right of potential legal action for breaches.
